

## Trúarjáttan

### 1. Gud er ævigur og trúeindur

- Vit trúgva, at Gud er ein og ævigur, opinberaður sum Faðirin, Sonurin og Heilagi Andin – triggir persónar, men ein Gud.

- Skriftstøð:

- Matteus 28:19: "Farið tí út og gerið øll fólkasløg til lærusveinar, doypið teir til navn Faðirsins, Sonarins og Heilaga Andans."

- 2 Korintbræv 13:14: "Náði Harrans Jesu Krists, kærleiki Guds og samfelag Heilaga Andans veri við tykkum øllum!"

### 2. Vit trúgva, at Bíblían er innblásta orð Guds. Hon er álítandi, sannførandi og vegleiðandi fyri okkara dagliga lív.

- Skriftstøð:

- 2 Timoteus 3:16: "Øll skriftin er innblást av Gudi og nyttug til lærdóm, til at sannføring, til rættleiðing, til uppfostran í rættvís."

- 2 Pætur 1:20-21: "Fyrst og fremst mugu tit vita tað, at einki profetorð í skriftini er givið til egna týðing. Tí aldri er nakað profetorð komið fram av vilja menniskja; nei, drivnir av Heilaga Andanum talaðu heilagir menn Guds."

### 3. Synd hevur skilt menniskju frá Gudi

- Vit trúgva, at synd hevur skilt okkum frá Gudi og Hansara ætlan fyri lív okkara. Synd førir til deyða og fortaping.

- Skriftstøð:

- Rómbrevið 3:23: "Øll hava syndað, og teimum fattast dýrd Guds."

- Rómbrevið 6:23: "Tí lønin, ið syndin gevur, er deyði, men náðigáva Guds er ævigt lív í Kristi Jesusi, Harra okkara."

### 4. Jesus er Sonur Guds og okkara Frelsari

- Vit trúgva, at Jesus Kristus er bæði Gud og menniskja. Hann livdi eitt syndafrítt lív, doyði á krossinum fyri syndir okkara, reis upp triðja dagin og er nú sitandi við høggru hond Guds.

- Skriftstøð:

- Jóhannes 1:1-5: "Í upphavi var Orðið, og Orðið var hjá Gudi, og Orðið var Gud."

- Rómbraevið 5:8: "Men Gud vísir kærleika Sín til okkara við, at Kristus doyði fyri okkum, meðan vit enn vóru syndarar."

## 5. Vit eru frelst av náði við trúgv

- Vit trúgva, at frelsa er ein ókeypiss gáva frá Gudi, sum vit fáa við trúgv á Jesus. Hetta merkir, at okkara syndir verða fyrigivnar, og vit fáa eitt nýtt lív í Gudi.

- Skriftstøð:

- Efesusbrævið 2:8-9: "Tí av náði eru tit frelst, við trúgv – og tað ikki av tykkum sjálvum, tað er gáva Guds, ikki av verkum – fyri at eingin skal rósa sær."

- Rómbraevið 10:9: "Tí um tú við munninum játtar Jesus sum Harra og trýrt í hjartanum, at Gud reisti Hann upp frá hinum deyðu, so skalt tú verða frelstur."

## 6. Vatndópur og dópur Heilaga Andans

- Vit trúgva, at vatndópur er ein lýsing av okkara nýggja lívi í Kristusi, og at dópur Heilaga Andans gevur okkum kraft og andalig gávur.

- Skriftstøð:

- Matteus 3:16: "Tað ið Jesus var doypur, kom Hann við tað sama upp úr vatninum, og Himmalin opnaðist fyri Honum, og hann sá Anda Guds dala niður sum dúvu og koma yvir Hann."

- Ápostlasøgan 1:8: "Men tit skulu fáa kraft, tað ið Heilagi Andin kemur yvir tykkum, og tit skulu vera vitni Míni."

## 7. Samkoman – Kristi likam

- Vit trúgva, at samkoman er Kristi likam á jørðini og ein samfelagsliga samanseting av øllum, ið trýr á Jesus. Samkoman hevur fingið uppgávuna at boða evangelið og vera ein miðdepil fyri kærleika og samfelag.

- Skriftstøð:

- 1 Korintbrævið 12:27: "Men nú eru tit likam Kristusar, og limir hvør fyri seg."

- Efesusbrævið 1:22-23: "Alt legði Hann undir fótur Hansara og gav samkomuni Hann sum høvd yvir øllum, henni, sum er likam Hansara, fyllt av Honum, ið fyllir alt í øllum."

## 8. Gud hevur ein ætlan fyri lív okkara

- Vit trúgva, at Gud hevur eitt endamál fyri hvørt menniskja – at tilbiðja Hann, vaksa í kærleika, og tæna í Hansara ríki.

- Skriftstøð:

- Jeremias 29:11: "Tí Eg veit, hvat Eg ætli og havi í huga viðvíkjandi tykkum – sigur HARRIN – friðarætlanir og ekki vanlukkuætlanir, at geva tykkum framtíð og vón."

- Matteus 28:19-20: "Farið tí út og gerið øll fólkasløg til lærusveinar, doypjið teir til navn Fæðirsins, Sonarins og Heilaga Andans."

## 9. Ævigt lív og Guds endaliga dómur

- Vit trúgva, at øll menniskju skulu liva æviga lív – annaðhvørt í Guds nærveru (Himmalin) ella í ævigari skild frá Gudi (Helviti), alt eftir hvussu vit hava svarað boðskapinum um Jesus.

- Skriftstøð:

- Jóhannes 3:16: "Tí so elskaði Gud heimin, at Hann gav Son Sín, hin einborna, fyri at hvør tann, ið trýr á Hann, skal ikki fortapast, men hava ævigt lív."

- Opinberingin 20:15: "Um onkur ikki fanst skrivaður í bók lívsins, varð hann kastaður í eldsjógvin."

## 10. Jesus kemur aftur

- Vit trúgva, at Jesus Kristus skal koma aftur í dýrd fyri at taka samkomuna heim til Sín í Himmlí.

- Skriftstøð:

- Ápostlasøgan 1:11: "Hesin Jesus, sum varð tikin frá tykkum upp til Himmals, skal koma aftur á sama hátt, sum tit sóu Hann fara til Himmals."

- Opinberingin 22:12: "Eg komi skjótt, og løn Mín er við Mær til at lata ein og hvønn fáa, eftir sum verk hansara er."

## 1. God is Eternal and Triune

We believe that God is one and eternal, revealed as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—three persons, yet one God.

### Scriptures:

- Matthew 28:19: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."
- 2 Corinthians 13:14: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."

## **2. The Bible is the Inspired Word of God**

We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God. It is reliable, authoritative, and a guide for our daily lives.

### **Scriptures:**

- 2 Timothy 3:16: "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness."
- 2 Peter 1:20-21: "Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit."

## **3. Sin Separates Humanity from God**

We believe that sin has separated us from God and His purpose for our lives. Sin leads to death and destruction.

### **Scriptures:**

- Romans 3:23: "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."
- Romans 6:23: "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

## **4. Jesus is the Son of God and Our Savior**

We believe that Jesus Christ is both fully God and fully human. He lived a sinless life, died on the cross for our sins, rose on the third day, and is now seated at the right hand of God.

### **Scriptures:**

- John 1:1-5: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."
- Romans 5:8: "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

## **5. We Are Saved by Grace Through Faith**

We believe that salvation is a free gift from God, received by faith in Jesus. This means our sins are forgiven, and we are given new life in God.

### **Scriptures:**

- Ephesians 2:8-9: "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast."
- Romans 10:9: "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."

## **6. Water Baptism and Baptism in the Holy Spirit**

We believe that water baptism is an outward declaration of our new life in Christ, and that baptism in the Holy Spirit empowers us and gives us spiritual gifts.

### **Scriptures:**

- Matthew 3:16: "As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Him."
- Acts 1:8: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses."

## **7. The Church – The Body of Christ**

We believe that the Church is the body of Christ on earth and a community of all who believe in Jesus. The Church is tasked with sharing the Gospel and being a center of love and fellowship.

### **Scriptures:**

- 1 Corinthians 12:27: "Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it."
- Ephesians 1:22-23: "And God placed all things under His feet and appointed Him to be head over everything for the Church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills everything in every way."

## **8. God Has a Plan for Our Lives**

We believe that God has a purpose for every person—to worship Him, grow in love, and serve in His kingdom.

### **Scriptures:**

- Jeremiah 29:11: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."
- Matthew 28:19-20: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you."

## **9. Eternal Life and God's Final Judgment**

We believe that all people will live eternally—either in God's presence (Heaven) or separated from God (Hell), depending on their response to the message of Jesus.

### **Scriptures:**

- John 3:16: "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."
- Revelation 20:15: "Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire."

## **10. Jesus Will Return**

We believe that Jesus Christ will return in glory to take the Church home to be with Him in Heaven.

### **Scriptures:**

- Acts 1:11: "This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven."
- Revelation 22:12: "Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with Me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done."
